Local bus numbers 1 (Stephanshorn), 4 (Guggeien), 7 (Neudorf) or 11 (Mörschwil) stop right outside the St.Gallen Cantonal Hospital. The number 10 bus (Abacus-Platz) stops at the Spitalstrasse bus stop (by the parking B).

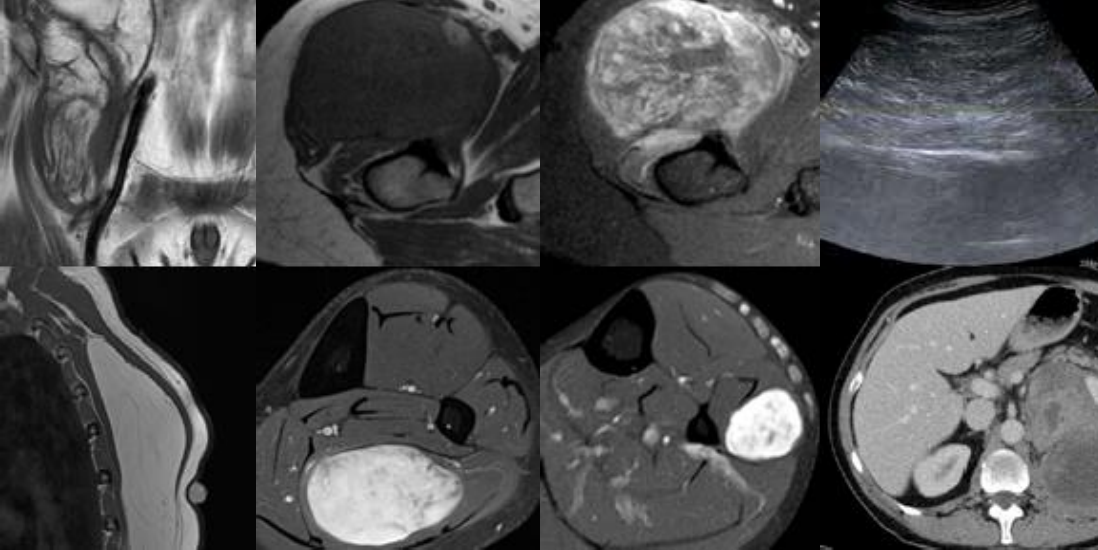
